



Statement of Intent



The below signed representatives of the UN Armenia and the Ministry of High-Tech Industry, and the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports state their intention to create a special “Armenia and UN” postage stamp dedicated to the 30th anniversary of the Armenia’s accession to the UN and launch of related stamp design contest.


Together with the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports, UN Armenia will announce the launch of “Armenia and UN” special stamp competition open for students of all ages representing the idea of UN’s partnership with Armenia - **“The future we want”**.

The winner will be announced 3-4 weeks later after the submission deadline. The winning design will be presented to the relevant authorities to be used for producing the “Armenia and UN” stamp, and she/he will attend the redemption ceremony. Selected students will get consolation prizes, all the works will later participate in virtual or actual exhibition.


